2020 - In House Competition 3 Snooker and 1 Billiard (All Timed Matches)

General Rules / Guidelines / FAQ

- Snooker match (Best of 3) is timed and to be completed in 90 mins, the referee is to stop the clock between frames, if 90 minutes elapses and the colours have started the frame is played out to determine the winner, if the players are not to the colours then who is in front will be declared the winner.
- The maximum start for any snooker match is 30 points.
- The Two Lowest Handicap Snooker Players must always play each other, so Captains will need to draw the Top 2 Snooker Players – If more than 2 are on the same handicap it will just be the first name out.
- Billiards match is always played the third match on (Timed 75 Mins)
- The maximum start for any billiard match is 180 points.
- Any Player can play Billiards, they must be just nominated by the Captain on the Score Sheet before that Nights Play.
- Handicaps once all teams and players are known may be adjusted at the discretion of the NTBS for this new adjustment 30 points maximum for snooker and 180 maximum for billiards.
- Players must play 33% of available roster matches to play Finals.
- ❖ Foul and Miss: First time back no matter how much it misses by, after that no foul and miss as long as not hit hard enough to make sure the cue ball travels back to safety The cue ball must not end more than 1/3 from the object ball the player was trying to make contact with The referee should ask what ball they are going for if a red ball or the colour ball if not clear.
- Players must sign a player registration form on the night of the first game they engage in and abide to all conditions / directions of the LWC and the NTBS and understand their registration details may be passed on to the Department of Health
- ❖ \$5 per player per night must be paid, failure to pay the \$5 you will not be eligible to play the following game, unless you pay what will then be \$10
- Only the two players and the referee are allowed on the Southern brick wall of the LWC, no other people in this area.
- All Players / Spectators must be sitting down while drinking.
- Shared Equipment (Rests and Spiders) should be cleaned after each use.
- Snooker Cues (Players should not share their own cue or used shared cues).
- ❖ If a Player Is Not Well STAY HOME Captains should send players home who are also not well.
