New Fees

The NTEBA will be adjusting our player fees for the Start of the new Roster which is due to start 23rd February 2021, with team nominations closing on 18th February via the NTEBA web site (on-line nomination)

The are many reasons behind this change but mainly on making our sport more sustainable in the future and to help our Hotels / Clubs with fees, especially with the COVID-19 challenges and running their business in the future.

It will still be for players the cheapest orgainsed sport you can play, even though yes it will be a big increase from what the players pay now which is \$15 per roster (Basically \$1 per week including finals)

The new fee is \$25 per Team per week and this will be up to the Captain of the team or their nomination to collect that money each week and deposit into the NTEBA bank account with the team reference by the next business day.

Teams that are more than one week behind for the \$25 team payment will be marked as a forfeit for matches if they play the second week (match) and do not deposit the money owed.

This will definitely help with NTEBA finances and allow as an association to do more for our players in the form of representative matches, increased prize money, trophies, affiliation to the State body to enable our players to play in State events, training and keeping our sport with changes that occur and promoting our sport in the future, one area we need to grow is Juniors and at the same time look after our playing members and establishments (It is really a small amount to play a sport we all love)
